Dear Bretton Village Resident:

The City of Trenton is pleased to announce that Gaglio Construction, Inc., (734-281-7453) has been contracted by the City of Trenton to re-construct the street pavement on Camelot Drive during the 2019 construction season.

SCHEDULE

Construction of the project is scheduled to start on or about Tuesday, May 21, 2019. Due to Bretton Village's layout with somewhat limited access to the various parking areas, the project must be completed in more than one phase. Construction is slated to begin at the north end of Camelot Drive adjacent to King Road. Pavement replacements will be done half-width at a time which will allow access for emergency vehicles and general access to all properties, although street parking will be prohibited by Police order. Work will include removing existing pavement, installing some new storm sewer and constructing new concrete pavement with integral curb and gutter. Sidewalks and drive approaches will be replaced on an as-needed basis. Weather permitting, we anticipate that the first half of the project will be complete by the end of June 2019. Due to budgetary concerns, the southern portion may not be started until the 2020 paving season, but we will make every effort to complete all work this year.

TRAFFIC AND TRASH PICK-UP

The contractor will be working Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Appropriate traffic control signage will be in place. ***There will be no parking along any street under construction.*** All residents will be notified of deviations to the trash pick-up schedule, if any, but currently we do not anticipate any changes to the normal pick-up day. ***If anyone requires special medical attention or is in a wheelchair, please contact the Engineering Department at 675-8251 so the contractor can be informed of these conditions.***

MAIL DELIVERY

Mail service should not be interrupted.

THANK YOU

Your patience and cooperation will be appreciated during this construction project. Every effort will be made to minimize the inconveniences to Bretton Village residents and full restoration of disturbed areas will be made to the city's prescribed standards. We will have City representatives in the field during construction, feel free to talk to them at any time.

The Contractor will work as expeditiously as possible with the end result benefiting all. Thank you very much in advance for your anticipated patience and cooperation.
