Dear City of Trenton Resident:

The City of Trenton is pleased to announce that Gaglio Construction, Inc., (734-281-7453) has been contracted by the City of Trenton to perform pavement repairs in our city during the 2020 construction season.

SCHEDULE

All pavement replacement will be done half-width at a time. This will allow access for emergency vehicles and general access to all properties. Work will include removing existing pavement, base restoration (if applicable), and installing new concrete pavement with integral curb and gutter. Sidewalks and drive approaches will be replaced on an as-needed basis at the discretion of the City of Trenton Engineering Department. Please note that all new concrete requires seven (7) full days of cure to gain its full design strength. Please do not remove barricades/barrels at any time sooner. The Contractor will remove the barricades/barrels blocking a portion of the street/apron once this process has been completed. Each concrete repair area requires approximately ten days (10) to be completed.

- concrete removal (1 Day)
- base restoration/form installation (1 Day)
- concrete placement (1 Day)
- concrete curing process/restoration/sprinkler repairs (7 Days)

Please note that the above referenced outline is weather dependent.

TRAFFIC AND TRASH PICK-UP

The contractor will be working Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Appropriate traffic control signage will be in place. Trash pick-up and U.S.P.S. main services schedules will not be affected by construction operations. ***If anyone requires special medical attention or is in a wheelchair, please contact the Engineering Department at 675-8251 so the contractor can be informed of these conditions.***

Your patience and cooperation is appreciated as we attempt to maintain/improve the City of Trenton's road infrastructure.
