Dear City of Trenton Resident:

The City of Trenton is pleased to announce that Gaglio Construction, Inc., (734-281-7453) has been retained by the City of Trenton to perform pavement repairs in our city during the 2021 construction season. The construction season will commence in May and extend thru November, weather permitting.

SCHEDULE

Pavement replacement generally is done half-width at a time, thereby allowing access for emergency vehicles and attempting to minimize inconvenience. Sidewalks and drive approaches will be replaced only when necessary to correct a drainage problem, tripping hazard or another issue concerning city-owned utilities and is done solely at the discretion of the City of Trenton Engineering Department. Please note that all new concrete requires seven (7) full days of cure time to gain its sufficient strength to allow vehicular access with no damage to the new pavement. Please do not remove any barricades or barrels. The Contractor will remove the barricades/barrels blocking a portion of the street/apron once this process has been completed. The process for removal and replacement typically proceeds as follows, but may not be accomplished concurrently:

- concrete removal (1 Day)
- base restoration/form installation (1 Day)
- concrete placement (1 Day)
- concrete curing process/restoration/sprinkler repairs (7 Days)

Please note that the above referenced outline is weather dependent.

TRAFFIC AND TRASH PICK-UP

The contractor will generally be working Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Appropriate traffic control signage will be in place. Trash pick-up and U.S.P.S. main services schedules will not be affected by construction operations. ***If anyone requires special medical attention, is in a wheelchair or has other physical difficulties, please contact the Engineering Department at 675-8251 so arrangements can be made to accommodate any person's physical limitations.***

THANK YOU

Your patience and cooperation is appreciated as we attempt to maintain/improve the City of Trenton's road infrastructure. Every effort will be made to minimize the inconveniences to any of our residents and businesses affected by this work. We will have City representatives in the field during construction, feel free to talk to them at any time.
